Inca Engineered Molded Wood™ products are essentially “highly processed”, reconstituted wood, the same as particleboard, fiberboard or chipboard technology. Wood particles are first dried in a hot gas stream with a decreasing temperature from **1200° F to 280° F (648° C to 138° C)** over a time period exceeding 30 minutes and then mixed with a thermo set synthetic resin, deposited in a heat compression mold with **420° F (220° C)** temperature and pressed under **1400 PSI or 98 bar pressure**. During this process, the products receive an internal temperature of **220° F (105° C)** and maintain at an internal temperature in excess of **133° F (56° C)** for more than 30 minutes. The finished product will have a moisture content of not more than 9%. This process also destroys resident pest, insect, molds and fungi. Due to the high-density finished product, it is resistant to wood boring insects and future infestation.

Inca Engineered Molded Wood™ products are considered “processed wood” per IPPC-ISM15 and meet the requirement to be compliant with no additional heat treating or special stamps.

This Inca Engineered Molded Wood™ product is made from reconstituted wood. It is a newly “manufactured wood packaging material,” and, therefore, is not considered a “solid wood packaging material.” This product is considered “processed wood” and does not require any additional treatment for infestation or stamping on the pallet according to the IPPC-ISM-15 (International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures; No. 15)
